1. CONFERENCE VENUE: Collegium Polonicum, 69-100 Ślubice, ul. T. Kościuszki 1 (1 Kościuszki Street)
2. PLACE OF ACCOMMODATION: University Campus (osiedle studenckie Collegium Polonicum) in Ślubice, (Piłsudskiego Street no. 14)

All participants have accommodation in guestrooms of the academic campus – Piłsudskiego Street no. 14. For more information visit <http://dsslubice.amu.edu.pl/index.php?lang=en>. List of accommodation (room number) will be available at the concierge of the campus.

3. HOW TO GET TO THE CONFERENCE VENUE?

a) journey from Poznań to Ślubice on February 1st and from Ślubice to Poznań on February 2nd :

- by bus – it will depart from the Adam Mickiewicz Square in Poznań on February 1st at 6.30 a.m.
- the bus departure time from Ślubice to Poznań – February 2nd at 3.00 p.m.) (**request should be submitted to the Secretariat of the FPS&J Dean** – tel. +48 61 829 6626; e-mail: wnpid@amu.edu.pl).

b) by train to Rzepin:

- go to Rzepin and then from the Rzepin railway station to Ślubice with the University bus (**Please submit your demand to the gatehouse of the Collegium Polonicum (it is possible to make it till, February 1st) – tel. +48 61 829 6800;**

c) by train to Frankfurt (Oder)

- go to Frankfurt (Oder), then on foot (approx. 15 minutes) to the Collegium Polonicum.

Important information for all those intending to come to Ślubice by train:

Some trains from Warsaw (Warszawa) and Poznań stop in Frankfurt Oder. Those who come to Frankfurt Railway Station may take the cross-border bus to Ślubice – No. 983. The bus goes from the train station in Frankfurt Oder, through the stop at the Collegium Polonicum and your accommodation place (Piłsudski Street – "PLAC BOHATERÓW" bus stop). **Ticket price: €1,70.** The timetable is available on the website europe21.amu.edu.pl. You can also take a taxi.

4. FOOD

All conference participants are guaranteed meals: breakfast and lunch (on Thursday and Friday) and dinner on Thursday.

All meals will be served in the cafeteria *Europe* in the building of the Collegium Polonicum. Hours will be given in the conference program.

Dinner on Thursday will be served in the foyer of the Collegium Polonicum.
